If you are not able to achieve azimuth (flashing AZM on AAT display) and have used the troubleshooting tips concerning mounting, etc from the Quick Ref card. Use the following flowchart:

From startup, the AAT displays a flashing 'GPS' indicator to let you know it is attempting to <u>LOCATE</u> satellites. Once GPS location data has been established the AAT will flash AZM as it is attempting to calculate a GPS based azimuth reading. Once AZM is solid at any time, measurements can begin. If AZM remains flashing after 3-4 minutes, follow flowchart below
